

New Volunteer Opportunity Available!

NEWAHEC is collaborating with the Manitowoc County Prevention Coalition and the Lakeshore Health Care Alliance to coordinate a short-term, summer volunteer opportunity program for students 15-18 years old. Students will be required to apply for a position, interview for available volunteer opportunities, attend an orientation, and complete a job skills training as part of the volunteer program.

Following those steps, the student will then be placed at a community agency to complete their service work. Opportunities may include working outdoors, within the healthcare field, arts & crafts, and a number of other areas. The program will be 12 weeks in length and will provide students the opportunity to receive at least 25 hours of volunteer service. The VolunTEEN Program will begin on June 12th, 2017 and run through August 18th, 2017.

The purpose is to provide 20 to 25 students the opportunity to gain Life Skills Training, develop good work habits, learn about various careers, and have fun! Summer can be a great opportunity for youth to engage in projects that will build their skills, but also allow them to feel more connected to their community.

Applications will be evaluated once all forms have been received. NEWAHEC will contact **YOU** with the next steps!

An in-person interview may be scheduled to further discuss your interests and which volunteer placement may be the best fit. If you are accepted into the VolunTEEN Program, the applicant must commit to completing both the volunteer hours and the Life Skills Training Course.

Applicants should understand that there is limited space in the program and applying does not guarantee you a spot within the VolunTEEN Program. This program is not a first-come, first-serve program.
